


project description

- 11 YRT and Viva bus bays, welcoming pedestrian plazas under beautiful wooden trellises, weather-protected and heated waiting areas, large planters, bike racks, a passenger pick-up and drop-off area, indoor seating, washrooms and space for future retail.
- Cornell Bus Terminal is located northeast of Highway 7 and Ninth Line, just south of Markham Stouffville Hospital and the Cornell Community Centre and Library, in the City of Markham.
- A transit hub within walking distance to Markham-Stouffville Hospital and Cornell Community Centre & Library.



project status

 Construction started in 2018 and was delayed in 2020 due to unforeseen circumstances. The terminal construction is 92% complete and will open for service in summer 2022.

key benefits & features

- Provides a comfortable location for transit customers to arrive, transfer and depart, within a short walk of the hospital and community centre.
- Serves those who live and work in the Markham area and beyond. Strategically placed for transit connections, it's located near the eastern border of York Region and the western border of Durham Region.
- The terminal can be accessed by bike lanes

 raised and at street level. Bike racks are
 conveniently located on both the north and
 south plazas.
- There is no parking at the terminal. Cornell Bus Terminal is a part of the transit-oriented development in the Cornell community. Rather than parking, customers are encouraged to access the terminal by taking transit, walking, cycling or being dropped off.
